WASHINGTON, D.C. - Congresswoman Anna G. Eshoo, D-Palo Alto, released the following statement today on the resignation of Attorney General Alberto Gonzales.

"The resignation of Attorney General Gonzales is long overdue. Under his watch, the integrity of the Justice Department was undermined by a rampant politicization, a willful disregard for civil liberties, and repeated instances of providing false and misleading testimony to the Congress.

"The President's nominee for Attorney General should have the character and commitment to restore the trust of the American people by ensuring that the Justice Department upholds the Constitution and administers our nation's laws in a fair and impartial manner."
