

Inauguration Week Tour Availability

The following is a list of tour availability during the week of Inauguration. Congresswoman Eshoo's office will be happy to book tours for constituents but please keep in mind that these tours fill up quickly and therefore they may no longer be available.

United States Capitol:

The United States Capitol will be closed for tours starting Monday, January 19th through Wednesday, January 21st. They will resume regular tour hours on Thursday, January 22nd. All tours must be registered with the Capitol Visitors Center at least 24 hours in advance so we will be unable to book tours the day of. White House:

The White House will be closed the entire month of January in preparation for the incoming administration. No tours are available. We encourage you to visit the White House Visitor Center in the Department of Commerce building (15th & E St NW). It will be open from 7:30 am – 4:00 pm on January 21st through January 23rd and features many aspects of the White House including guided walks, talks, films, and lectures. National Archives:
