

## Rep. Eshoo Announces Funding for Port of Redwood City

Washington, D.C.—Rep. Anna G. Eshoo (D-Palo Alto) announced today that the Port of Redwood City will receive \$4 million in funding, which was approved in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. It will be used to accomplish maintenance dredging of the port entrance and turning basins providing full authorized channel availability.

“This project is crucial to preserve the commercial activity that passes daily through the Port of Redwood City. This is the only port serving the many industries in Silicon Valley and its maintenance is critical to our local economy,” said Rep. Eshoo. “The funding through the Army Corps of Engineers will return the port to its authorized depth of 30 feet and save thousands of jobs associated directly and indirectly with the Port of Redwood City.”
