Because of your commitment to ending the dominance of big money in politics, protecting our elections from foreign interference, and protecting and expanding the right to vote, you have received an A rating!

We are sharing this scorecard—which tracked 2019 key votes, bill co-sponsorships and positions on government reform issues—with the media and general public to make clear which Members of Congress are standing with their constituents to clean up Washington. We also published an advertisement with all the scores in the January 15th edition of *Roll Call*.


For your reference, the scorecard tracked votes and/or co-sponsorships on:

- For the People Act (H.R. 1)
- SAFE Act (H.R. 2722)
- SHIELD Act (H.R. 4617)
- Voting Rights Advancement Act (H.R. 4) and the motion to recommit on the final vote
- Democracy for All Amendment (H.J. Res. 2)
- DISCLOSE Act of 2019 (H.R. 2977)

In addition to these bills, members are also graded on whether they have chosen to reject corporate PAC money for their campaigns.

Americans want their politicians to fight for a democracy that's open, accountable, and responsive to their needs. Thank you for your leadership in standing up for your constituents and our democracy.
